

Dear Double Oak Resident:

Waste Management is pleased to be the waste and recycling collection services provider for Double Oak. Like Double Oak, Waste Management is focused on sustainability—creating, deploying, and nurturing community programs aimed at inspiring change for a greener tomorrow!

RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION

Waste Management provides waste collection, recycling, brush, and bulk pick-up services.

Double Oak residents should use the green cart with the yellow lid for recyclables. The green cart with the green lid should be used for items considered trash. See the other side of this brochure for a description of what goes into the recycle bin and what would be considered trash.

Waste Management provides the following service to Double Oak residents:

- Weekly trash collection- plus two bags
- Weekly recycling collection- new recycling cart only
- Once-a-month brush/bulk pick up- third Friday each month

BRUSH AND BULK ITEMS

Waste Management will collect bundled brush and bulk items curbside the third Friday of each month.

What is a bulk item? A bulk item is an appliance, piece of furniture, or other residential items that is too large for the container. Appliance such as refrigerators must have the Freon removed by a licensed technician and be tagged before being placed at the curb for collection. Items containing hazardous chemicals such as gasoline, Freon, and oil will not be collected. Please do not place dirt, concrete or construction debris inside your containers that will make the items too heavy for collection. If you have large amounts of these items, please contact us at 972-315-5400 for instructions on how to have these items collected. Bulk and brush that exceed the limitation can be picked up for an additional fee. Please call 972-315-5400 to schedule a quote for removal.

What is not considered bulk waste? Items larger than 4 feet, heavier than 75 pounds or any vehicles or parts will not be collected as bulk waste.

BAGGED LEAVES AND BRUSH (GREEN WASTE)

Waste Management will collect up to 15 bags of yard waste on a weekly basis on the designated trash collection day. On the third Friday of each month, Waste Management will pick up an additional 15 bags plus 3 cubic yards of bulky waste if the resident calls WM Customer Service at 972-315-5400 at least 24 hours prior to the third Friday collection day.

Brush- 3 cubic yard limit

- Cut into 4-foot lengths
- Tied up in bundles weighing no more than 50 pounds each
- Up to 3 cubic yards in volume allowed (3'x3'x9')

FREE LANDFILL DISPOSAL

Double Oak residents can now go to the WM DFW Lewisville Landfill 12 times a calendar year for free. The DFW Landfill is located at 1600 S. Railroad St., Lewisville, TX 75067.

- Residents are responsible for transporting their own waste.
- All loads brought to the landfill must be securely covered to prevent littering or fees will be charged.
- Residents may dispose of 3 cubic yards (approx. a pick-up bed.)
- Residents are required to bring a valid ID and most recent Waste Management bill with matching address as proof of residency.
- The free disposal is for residential waste only. Commercial and industrial waste will not be accepted free of charge.
- No other pass is required.

Waste Management's **At Your Door Special CollectionSM** provides residents with front-porch service to collect the difficult, sometimes hazardous, and hard-to-recycle items that almost every household accumulates. Waste Management will collect the pesticides, household chemicals, electronic waste, batteries, fluorescent lamps, automotive waste products (including oil), paints, thinners, and dozens of other items that don't belong with your recyclables or regular curbside waste pickup. You can easily schedule a home collection of these items.

Automotive Products

Antifreeze, batteries, brake fluid, motor oil and filter, fuels

Household Cleaners

Ammonia, heavy-duty cleaners, tile/ shower cleaners, rust removers

Lamps

CFL bulbs, fluorescent lights, fluorescent tubes

Medical Waste

syringes, sharps, needles, lancets

Electronic Waste

PCs, MP3 players, iPods®, TVs, DVD players, cell phones, computers, monitors, and more

Garden Chemicals

Fertilizers, herbicides, insect sprays, pesticides, weed killers

Paint Products

Caulk, glue, paint, stripper, stain, thinner, wood preservative, artist paints

Swimming Pool Chemicals

Chlorine tablets and liquid, pool acid, stabilizer

MATERIAL THAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED: Ammunition, medicine, explosives, asbestos, leaking containers, commercial chemicals, or hazardous materials in containers larger than five gallons.

CURBSIDE TIMING

To ensure collection, carts must be at the curb no later than 7 AM on the scheduled trash day pick up. Double Oak requires that you place your trash and recycling carts, including third Friday bulk, at the curb no earlier than 8 AM the day before collection and to remove the carts from the curb by 8 AM on the day following your collection.





When Double Oak residents use **Recycle Often Recycle Right** SM, great things happen. By recycling everyday items like those shown below, tons of raw materials, time, energy, and money are saved. The recycled materials become new products. If you recycle an aluminum can today, it could be back at the store as a new one in 60 days.

Recyclables go in the green cart with the yellow lid.
Only place acceptable recyclables shown below in your recycling cart- no sorting needed.
Containers should be rinsed and free of food and liquid.
Do not put recyclables in plastic bags.
Place your cart at the curb before 7 AM on Fridays.
