Ms. Jan Rugg, representing Atmos Energy Corporation, stated:

- This item was for approval of a rate review mechanism or “blue print” for the process to review rates
- It was an initial step in preparing their rate filing to the Texas Railroad Commission

Deputy Mayor Pro-Tem Wills asked what if Double Oak did not agree

Ms. Rugg responded:

- Atmos would go forward with the process on a rate schedule and take their case to the Railroad Commission
- Double Oak would take their individual case to the Railroad Commission and would be responsible for the legal fees
